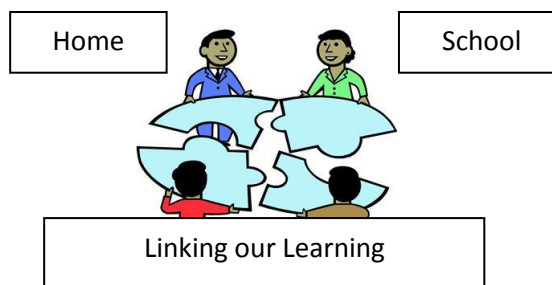
Blue Book Bags
