People who help us- we are learning about **people who help us in our community**, if you have a job that relates to this, we would love to have you in to talk to the children to share your experience.

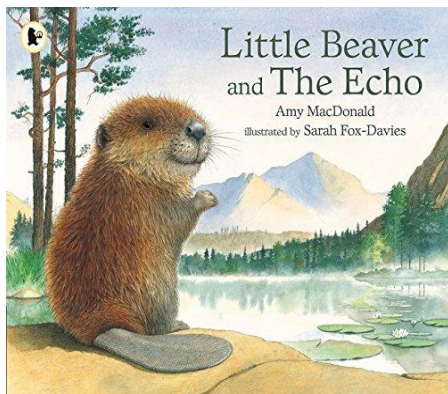
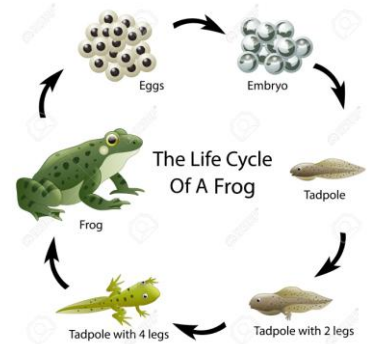

This week in your Wow Books, you can create any life cycle of your choice or something else that you'd like to show off.

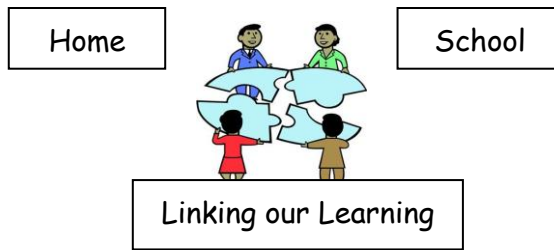


Soft Finish
